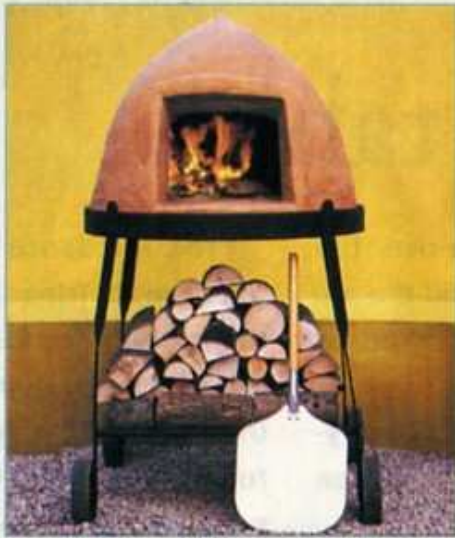


# CHIC COOKOUTS
